**Note:** Because each Tribe is considered a sovereign government, FOIA requests for tribal documents must be submitted to the Tribal Government. A quick check suggests that most Tribes do have something akin to FOIA and Open Government laws, but they are enforceable only through the Tribe and not by the Federal Government.
